# a) Type, format, and estimated amount of data

### • Types of data:

- Location (GPS if the device has GPS; Wi-Fi–only models use approximate location based on Wi-Fi networks)
- o User activity (screen time, touch interactions, gestures)
- o Device status (battery, temperature, memory, CPU)
- o Diagnostic data and usage statistics (app usage frequency, error reports)
- o Network data (Wi-Fi network name, signal strength, data transfer)
- Sensor metadata (e.g., accelerometer, gyroscope if present in the model)
- Data formats: XML, CSV, binary, system logs
- **Estimated data volume:** From a few MB per day to several hundred MB per month depending on usage intensity and enabled services (e.g., synchronization, backups).

### b) Real-time data generation

A tablet can generate data continuously and in real time, e.g., during location tracking (if supported), app usage monitoring, and system status reporting.

## c) Data storage

- **Locally:** App data, browsing history, user files, system logs stored until manually deleted or after a factory reset.
- **Remotely** (**Google Cloud**): Backups, synchronized accounts (contacts, calendars, documents, photos) typically retained for up to 57 days after backup is disabled or until manually deleted.
- **Automatic deletion:** Some system logs are cleared periodically (e.g., every 7–30 days).

### d) Data access, download, and deletion

### Access and download:

- o In Android settings: Settings  $\rightarrow$  Privacy  $\rightarrow$  Your data in Google
- o Via Google Takeout (takeout.google.com) full data export option

### • Deletion:

- o Locally: through app settings, file manager, or factory reset
- o Remotely: via Google account or privacy management panel
- **Technical measures:** Privacy Dashboard (Android 14+), GDPR- and Data Act-compliant APIs
- Service conditions and quality: Data access requires an active Google account, a functional device, and an internet connection

### **TABLETS WITH ANDROID OS - Related Service**

# a) Data collected by the service

• Nature: Location (if supported), app usage data, diagnostics, error logs

- Volume: From a few dozen KB to several hundred MB per month
- **Frequency:** Collected in real time or during synchronization (e.g., once a day)
- **Storage:** Stored on Google servers until manually deleted or automatically removed after a defined period (e.g., 57 days after backup deactivation)

# b) Data generated by the service

Synchronization history, error reports, and backup metadata – available for download via Google Takeout.

## c) Use of data

Google uses data to provide services such as synchronization, personalization, and security. Users may consent to share data with third-party apps and services.

## d) Identity of future data holder

Google Ireland Limited, Gordon House, Barrow Street, Dublin 4, Ireland (for EU users).

### e) Means of communication

Contact via support.google.com, help forms, and the privacy center.

## f) Request for data sharing with third parties

Available in Google account settings  $\rightarrow$  "Data sharing" or in app settings. Consent may be withdrawn at any time.

### g) Right to lodge a complaint

Users may file a complaint with the data protection authority – in Poland, UODO (uodo.gov.pl).

### h) Trade secrets

Google acts as the data controller and may hold proprietary trade secrets regarding data analysis algorithms.

# i) Duration of the agreement

The agreement remains in effect as long as the Google account is active. Account deletion ends data processing and removes most associated data.
